FOOTBALL PLAYOFFS



The Desert View Jaguars advanced to the playoffs for the first time since 2016 and for the first time in school history got to host the first round on their home turf against the Millennium Tigers. The stands were packed and ready to watch a great game. Both teams came out with a hunger and fight to win and advance to the next round. What began as a slow start to the game with a score of 0-0 at the end of the first quarter led to an unforgettable game. The beginning of the second quarter was just the start as the Jaguars got put on board with the first touchdown of the game, that didn't last for long until the Tigers made their first touchdown making the score tied 6-6, the Jaguars came back and scored another touchdown before halftime making the score 6-12. After the half the Tigers got their first lead of the game with a touchdown and extra point making the score 13-12 and by the 4th quarter the Jaguars stopped the Tigers and went on to score two more touchdowns making the final score 13-26. The Jaguars won the first round and moved on to the quarter-finals to take on the Desert Edge Scorpions in Goodyear Arizona.



Carlo Arvizu #3-LB: "Making the playoffs this year was a little nerve-racking, but mostly exciting. It was a cool thing to experience, especially because Desert View has never had a home playoff game. It felt good for us to do that for the first time."



Coach of the year Robert Bonillas:

"It feels good to be recognized. I did not expect it. I must say, the recognition would not have been possible without the hard work from our coaching staff and the great effort our boys displayed throughout the season." "I noticed a few things we can learn from this team. Teams need to work hard in the weight room & the classroom. Teams need to make good decisions on and off the field. Teams need to believe they are prepared to WIN" "One of my favorite moments from this season was the atmosphere at our first home play-off game. We had alumni, faculty, family and friends in the stands cheering loud the whole game. The team had one of its best performance on the field. The victory gave us our first 10 win season and our first home pay-off win. It was a group effort."



The next week the Desert View Jaguars took a trip to Goodyear for the quarter finals to play against the Desert Edge Scorpions. The Jaguars came out with a tough start to the game with 0-13 lead by the Scorpions in the first quarter. At the beginning of the 2nd quarter the Jaguars scored their first touchdown and extra point making the score 7-13 and by the end of the quarter the Scorpions had the lead 7-19. By the beginning of the 3rd quarter the Jaguars scored their second touchdown making the score 13-19 making that the final score for the Jaguars as they were stopped by the Scorpions the rest of the game. Desert Edge then went on to score two more touchdowns making the final score 13-31. The Jaguars had a great season and a great record this year but that sadly came to an end quicker than many people wanted and just like that the 2021 season came to an end.
